Message from the Pastor

This month I want to use this space to share some suggestions about how you might help contribute to the overall health of the planet. My sermon this past week was about environmental stewardship, and the sermon really moved a lot of you to begin talking and sharing ideas. That's Great!! I'm excited too! I have already ordered some bamboo fiber cups to replace the Styrofoam cups we use in Sunday School! We have an awesome responsibility to care for the creation with which God has entrusted us, so if you can...

- 1. Plant a tree or donate a tree.
- 2. Join a local park, river or highway clean-up.
- 3. Use non-toxic cleaning products.
- Replace inefficient incandescent light bulbs with efficient LEDs.
- Carpool, ride your bike, use public transportation or drive an electric or hybrid car.

- Stop using disposable plastics, especially singleuse plastics like bottles, bags and straws.
- Use cloth towels instead of paper towels.
- Change your paper bills to online billing. You'll be saving trees and the fuel it takes to deliver your bills by truck.
- 9. Use reusable bottles for water, and reusable mugs for coffee.
- 10. Bring reusable bags when you shop.
- 11. Pack your lunch in a reusable bag.
- Take a shorter shower and use a water-saving shower head.
- 13. Run your dishwasher only when it's full to save water and energy.
- 14. Turn off lights when you leave a room.



- 15. Take the stairs instead of the elevator to save energy ... (and get exercise!).
- 16. Purchase energy efficient appliances.
- 17. Take steps to make your home more energy efficient.






Summer Sunday School


Join us for a new Sunday School class for the summer beginning **Sunday, June 9th**. It will be led by David Greene, and will meet in the Library.




Mission Trip to Peru ~ July 17—27, 2019


