PRAYER OF CONFESSION

One: Isaiah testified to God's call on his life – a call he lived out through his prophetic words and actions. We confess that so many voices clamor for our attention that

God's word is hard to hear. When we have been called to be witnesses of God's activity in the world and in our lives, and we have been unwilling to respond,

ALL: *Merciful God, forgive us.*

One: When Jesus' disciples heard the call of Christ, their lives were changed forever as they turned to follow Jesus. When we do not expect to hear life-changing words, and fail to discern God's call on our lives,

ALL: *Merciful God, forgive us.*

One: We are empowered by the Holy Spirit to recognize and to respond to the invitation of Jesus to follow him, even when that means traveling unknown and unfamiliar paths...

ALL: *Merciful God, forgive us when we fail, and take from us the fear and uncertainty that hinder us. Cleanse us from all that hinders our hearing your voice, and fill us anew with the Holy Spirit, that we may joyfully respond to Christ's call on our lives. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.*

How does baptism remind and assure you that Christ's one sacrifice on the cross benefits you personally?

In this way: Christ instituted this outward washing and with it promised that, as surely as water washes away the dirt from the body, so certainly his blood and his Spirit wash away my soul's impurity, that is, all my sins.

Why then does the Holy Spirit call baptism the water of rebirth and the washing away of sins? ***God has good reason for these words. To begin with, God wants to teach us that the blood and Spirit of Christ take away our sins just as water removes dirt from the body. But more important, God wants to assure us, by this divine pledge and sign, that we are as truly washed of our sins spiritually as our bodies are washed with water physically.***
